This bulletin is being sent to all schools that have registered teams for the above event to be held at the Snowcentre on Monday 20th April 2015. This event is organised by Impulse and BISS Racing. We would like to thank the management and staff of the Snowcentre, Hemel Hempstead, The event sponsors and all volunteers for their assistance, without whom there would be not be a race.

**Race Information**

The races will be a special slalom consisting of 2 runs down the same course. The morning race will be set with stubby gates and will be for Preps/Primaries with the following age groups taking part: U10, U12 and U14.

The later race, for seniors/secondaries will be run through full gates with the following age groups taking part: U14, U16, U18 and U21. Should any racers from the U12/U10 age groups wish to represent an older school, they will have to 'race up' into the U14 category. **We would like to add that we do not recommend U12's racing through full gates.**

**Closing dates - Please note that we MUST have a team list (In the race order) of names, YOB and genders before the 13th or April. Failure to supply this will jeopardize your schools entry.**

Every attempt will be made to keep to the event schedule; however the organisers reserve the right to amend the schedule as appropriate.

**Open Practice on the recreational slope from 08.30 - 09.15 and 12.30-13.15 is included as part of the entry fee. Thereafter, if racers wish to ski on the non-race section of the slope, they will have to pay at the standard rate available to the general public. Any racer who elects to ski on the non-race slope must bear in mind that the slope is open to the general public and extreme care will be needed. Snowcentre staff will remove anyone skiing in an inconsiderate manner and there will be no refund of unused fees.**

### **Race Rules / Health & Safety**

- ONLY qualified and accredited coaches and race officials be allowed in the Start Area because of the restricted size of the start area and the impact of overall numbers on the authorised fire capacity of the arena.
- Ski preparation is not allowed anywhere inside the Snowcentre
- Racers will have access to the Locker Area, including lockers (£1deposit) for valuables. The Snowcentre will accept no responsibility for valuables left unattended.
- Inspection on foot by either racers or coaches is not permissible
- Racers will be advised of the method of inspection prior to the start of course inspection.
