



The Travel Places ISA Schools Ski Racing Indoor Championships 2017 The Snowcentre, Hemel Hempstead - 24th April 2017 Final Race Bulletin: Timetable, Information.

This bulletin is being sent to all schools that have registered teams and individual entrants for the above event to be held at the Snowcentre on Monday 24th April 2017. This event is run by Impulse and BISS Racing on behalf of the ISA.

We would like to thank the management and staff of the Snowcentre, Hemel Hempstead, The event sponsors and all volunteers for their assistance, without whom there would be not be a race.

Race Information

The races will be a special slalom consisting of 2 runs down the same course. The morning race will be set with stubby gates and will be for Preps/Primaries with the following age groups taking part: U8, U10, U12 and U14.

The later race, for seniors/secondaries will be run through full gates with the following age groups taking part: U14, U16, U18 and U21. Should any racers from the U12/U10 age groups wish to represent an older school, they will have to 'race up' into the U14 category. We would like to add that we do not recommend U12's racing through full gates.

Programme and Timetable

The times given below are provisional and may alter on the day, but in order to meet the tight timescales please ensure you are ready to start on time and listen carefully for any announcements as the timetable may be pulled forward if time allows.

Every attempt will be made to keep to the event schedule; however the organisers reserve the right to amend the schedule as appropriate.

Open Practice on the recreational slope from 08.30 - 09.30 and 12.30-13.30 is included as part of the entry fee.

Race Rules / Health & Safety

- **ONLY** Coaches working for the organisers will be allowed on the hill and specifically the start/finish areas due to the restricted size of these areas and the impact of overall numbers on the authorised fire capacity of the arena. **Any coaches/teachers or parents not adhering to this are in danger of having their school disqualified from the competition.**
- We will assign various roles for the volunteer helpers for each event through the day. These helpers will have access to the slope. **Any coaches/teachers or parents not adhering to this are in danger of having their school disqualified from the competition.**
- Ski preparation is not allowed anywhere inside the Snowcentre
- Racers will have access to the Locker Area, including lockers (£1 returnable deposit) for valuables. The Snowcentre will accept no responsibility for valuables left unattended.
- Inspection on foot by either racers or coaches is not permissible
